

• Perissa & Perivolos – Long stretches of black volcanic sand, known for water sports, beach bars, and relaxed vibes.



Rates For Season 2025

Looking at how the 5-star hotel scene in Santorini plays out over the 2025 season, some clear patterns stand out—and a few are surprising.



June & July are the real stars of summer

Although August is typically seen as peak travel time, the data tells a different story. Prices are higher in June and July, which means people intend to pay more to visit during these months in order to avoid the August heatwave.. Hotels are nearly full, and rates stay strong—these are the most profitable months.

August isn't as hot as it seems

Yes, it's still busy, and lots of hotels are open, but prices actually dip. That usually means demand softens a bit. Maybe it's the heat, maybe it's the crowds, or maybe travelers are just getting a little extra-cautious and tend to avoid what they perceive as summer's busiest month.

September makes a strong comeback

Once August fades, September picks up again—and prices rise. It's still sunny, the sea's warm, and the island is a little more relaxed. This month has become a favorite for travelers who want the full Santorini experience without the peak-season chaos.

Hotel operations stay steady... until late October

Most hotels stay open through summer, but from mid-October, closures begin, and both prices and room availability drop fast. That's the seasonal wind-down in action.

Bottom Line

If you're a hotel, lean into June, July, and September—they bring in the best rates and guests who are happy to stay longer. And if you're a traveler? Skip August. The sweet spot is just before or after it, when Santorini is still stunning but a bit calmer (and totally worth it).

Room Selling Power

Santorini's luxury hotels are in high demand, but some stand out more than others. The Room Selling Power ranking reflects a hotel's ability to fill its rooms based on reputation, popularity, location, reviews, value perception, as well as overall demand and size of room inventory.

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


What's Happening?

- Spring to Summer Boom (March-August 2024): Average searches per hotel start at 5,000 in March, climb • steadily, and peak at nearly 10,000 in July. August searches rank a close second after July, indicating that interest is still maintained for September stays, a time when Santorini is at its busiest.
- Fall Drop-Off (September–November 2024): Interest fades after summer, dropping to 6,000 in October and ٠ hitting around 4,000 in November.
- Winter Slowdown (December 2024–February 2025): The quietest months, with searches bottoming out at just ٠ over 2,000 in December.
- Spring Rebound (March 2025+): As expected, searches start creeping up again, signaling the start of the next tourist wave.

Santorini's luxury hotel demand is highly seasonal-if you're a traveler, book early for summer. If you're in the hotel business, adjust pricing and marketing to match the trends.

Estimated Revenue Distribution

The chart below provides a breakdown of revenue distribution, highlighting the dominance of select high-end properties in Santorini's luxury hotel market.



Key Insights:

- **Market Concentration** The top 5 hotels, led by Canaves Epitome (5%) and Canaves Oia Suites (4%), account for over 20% of total revenues, showcasing the influence of prestigious luxury brands in Santorini.
- Wide Revenue Spread While major resorts like Mystique (4%) and Santo Pure Oia Suites & Villas (3%) generate significant income, a vast majority of smaller hotels (50+ properties) collectively contribute only 25%, reinforcing the disparity between top-tier luxury and smaller boutique accommodations.

Santorini remains a premier luxury destination, where established names dominate revenue, and smaller hotels must innovate to carve out their market share.

Market Size

Using room rates, availability, and hotel capacities, we estimate the total **5-star hotel market in Santorini is valued at approximately €255 million**, highlighting its significance in the global luxury travel sector.
